The Agile PM™ Certification Exams: How do they Work?

You need to take two exams to become fully qualified: Agile PM™ Foundation and Agile PM™ Practitioner.

- **The Foundation** exam consists of 60 multiple-choice questions; you need 50% or more correct to pass. The exam is a one hour, closed book examination.
- **The Practitioner** exam is an objective testing examination. Each of the 4 questions is worth 15 marks. There are 60 marks available in total. An overall score of at least 30 out of the possible 60 is required to pass. The exam is a two hour, open-book examination (Manual only).
