Therefore, content and comments containing any of the following are not allowed for posting on our page, or in forums, and will be removed as soon as possible:

- Profane language or content,
- Personal attacks on individuals or specific groups,
- Any derogatory comments about CAL's course or its structure,
- Content that promotes, fosters or perpetuates discrimination on the basis of race, creed, colour, age, religion, gender, marital status, status with regard to public assistance, national origin, physical or mental disability or sexual orientation, or any other form of discrimination, in the sole discretion of CAL,
- Sexual content or links to sexual content,
- Conduct or encouragement of illegal, harmful or offensive activity,
- Content for the purposes of promoting a competitor or a competitive product,
- Content that relates to confidential or proprietary business information,
- Content that violates a legal ownership interest of any other party,
- Content determined to be inappropriate, in poor taste, or otherwise contrary to the purposes of this forum, in the sole discretion CAL.

CAL will remove any repeat offenders from any study groups as we deem necessary. All students are to comply with the student obligations as set out in the CAL Student Handbook.
